Jehovah is revealed as The Heavenly Father.

1 Chronicles 29:10 - "Therefore David blessed the LORD before all the assembly; and David said: "Blessed are You, LORD (Jehovah) God of Israel, our Father, forever and ever."

(Note: In various Bible translations, wherever the name LORD is written in all capital letters this is the translation for the Hebrew word for Jehovah. The Bible translation used in these verses is the New King James Version.)

Could it be possible that Jesus together with the Father is also Jehovah?

Please compare these parallel Bible passages found in the Old and the New Testament.

Jehovah is the eternal "I am" God.

Exodus 3:14-15 - "And God said to Moses, 'I AM WHO I AM.' And He said, 'Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, "I AM has sent me to you." Moreover God said to Moses, 'Thus you shall say to the children of Israel: "The LORD (Jehovah) God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has sent me to you. This is My name forever, and this is My memorial to all generations.""

John 8:58 - "Jesus said to them, 'Most assuredly, I say to you, before Abraham was, I AM.'"

Jehovah is the First and the Last, the one true God.

Isaiah 44:6 - "Thus says the LORD (Jehovah), the King of Israel, And his Redeemer, the LORD of hosts: 'I am the First and I am the Last; Besides Me there is no God.'"

Revelation 22:12-13 - "And behold, I am coming quickly, and My reward is with Me, to give to every one according to his work. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last" (verses 16-20 reveal Jesus as the one who speaks in these verses).

Jehovah is the eternal Creator God.

Psalm 102:25-27 - "Of old You (the LORD Jehovah, v.1) laid the foundation of the earth, And the heavens are the work of Your hands. They will perish, but You will endure; Yes, they will all grow old like a garment; Like a cloak You will change them, And they will be changed. But You are the same, And Your years will have no end."

Hebrews 1:8a,10-12 - "But to the Son (Jesus) He says:... 'You, LORD, in the beginning laid the foundation of the earth, And the heavens are the work of Your hands. They will perish, but You remain; And they will all grow old like a garment; Like a cloak You will fold them up, And they will be changed. But You are the same, And Your years will not fail."

John the Baptist prepared the way for the coming of the eternal Jehovah to man.

Isaiah 40:3 - "The voice of one crying in the wilderness: 'Prepare the way of the LORD (Jehovah); Make straight in the desert A highway for our God.'"

John 1:23,27,29,30 - "He (John the Baptist) said: 'I am "The voice of one crying in the wilderness: 'Make straight the way of the LORD,'" as the prophet Isaiah said. ... It is He who, coming after me, is preferred before me,

whose sandal strap I am not worthy to loose.'...
The next day John saw Jesus coming toward
him, and said, 'Behold! The Lamb of God who
takes away the sin of the world! This is He of
whom I said, "After me comes a Man who is
preferred before me, for He was before me.""

Jehovah is our Righteousness.

Jeremiah 23:5-6 - "Behold, the days are coming,' says the LORD (Jehovah), 'That I will raise to David a Branch of righteousness; A King shall reign and prosper, And execute judgment and righteousness in the earth. In His days Judah will be saved, And Israel will dwell safely; Now this is His name by which He will be called: THE LORD (Jehovah) OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS."

1 Corinthians 1:30 - "But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God-- and righteousness and sanctification and redemption."

Jehovah sanctifies us through His redemptive work.

Leviticus 20:8 - "And you shall keep My statutes, and perform them: I am the LORD (Jehovah) who sanctifies you."

Hebrews 13:12 - "Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people with His own blood, suffered outside the gate."

Jehovah alone is our Savior God.

Isaiah 43:11 - "I, even I, am the **LORD** (Jehovah), And besides Me there is no savior."

Acts 4:12 - (Peter says of Jesus vs.8,10) "Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved."

Jehovah alone can take away our sins by forgiving us.

Psalm 103:2-3 - "Bless the LORD (Jehovah), O my soul, And forget not all His benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases."

Matthew 9:2,6 - "Then behold, they brought to Him a paralytic lying on a bed. When Jesus saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, 'Son, be of good cheer; your sins are forgiven you.... But that you may know that the Son of Man has power on earth to forgive sins' —then He said to the paralytic, 'Arise, take up your bed, and go to your house.'"

Salvation comes to us through faith in Jehovah.

Joel 2:32 - "And it shall come to pass That whoever calls on the name of the LORD (Jehovah) Shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, As the LORD (Jehovah) has said, Among the remnant whom the LORD (Jehovah) calls."

Romans 10:9,10,13 - "That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. ... For 'whoever calls on the name of the LORD shall be saved.'"

Why was the child born of Mary to be called Jesus?

Matthew 1:21 - "And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name JESUS, for He will save His people from their sins."

Could there be more than one person in the Godhead of Jehovah and still be one God?

Genesis 1:26-27 - "Then God said, 'Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness;' ... So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them."

How could both the Father and Jesus be Jehovah?

John 14:7,11 - "If you had known Me (Jesus), you would have known My Father also; and from now on you know Him and have seen Him.... Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father in Me, or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves."

John 10:30 - "I and My Father are one."

Could there be another person in the Godhead besides the heavenly Father and Jesus?

Acts 5:3-4 - "But Peter said, 'Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit and keep back part of the price of the land for yourself? While it remained, was it not your own? And after it was sold, was it not in your own control? Why have you conceived this thing in your heart? You have not lied to men but to God."

Is it necessary to acknowledge Jesus as Jehovah, even as we do of the Heavenly Father?

John 5:23 - "All should honor the Son just as they honor the Father. He who does not honor the Son does not honor the Father who sent Him."
